Gentlemen;

Messrs. Allen & Collens have sent me a copy of your letter of February 17th to Mr. T. W. Rogers with reference to the proposed changes in the Mead Memorial Chapel. You state that the addition of pilasters will increase the cost considerably. Can you let me have the exact figure? Mrs. Mead has written me stating her decided preference for an earlier sketch of the chapel, which showed these pilasters between each of the large windows, and two large windows on the side instead of one.
